SUB: Recognition of Middle Department (VI, VII & VIII) without aid.

Sir,

With reference to your communication No. Fil dated 11-3-74 on the subject cited above, I have been directed to accord recognition to the middle department viz. classes VI, VII & VIII without aid w.e.f. 15-7-73 to 30-4-75 on the following terms and conditions.

1. The management shall follow the syllabi prescribed by the department from time to time.
2. The admission will be opened to all, irrespective of caste & creed.
3. The managing body will be constituted in accordance with the instructions contained in Delhi School Education Act 1973 and the instructions issued by the department from time to time.
4. The appointment of the staff will be made in accordance with the instructions contained in Delhi School Education Act 1973 and other circulars issued by the department from time to time.
5. Approved grades alongwith allowances as admissible ~~under the rules~~ under the rules will be allowed to the staff and only qualified and eligible persons will remain on the strength of the school. The management will execute service agreement form as per Delhi School Education Act 1973.
6. The management will have to provide facility of pension & gratuity.
7. Proper Library will be maintained.
8. The rate of fees to be realized from VI to VIII classes will be got approved by the department.
9. A separate Laboratory will be set up for the teaching of Science subject.
10. K.G. & Nursery classes which are unrecognised be shifted in a separate building immediately.
11. The school building will not be utilised for any commercial purposes.

SUB: Extension of Recognition without Grant-in-aid for the classes from K.G. to XII.

Sir,

With reference to your letter No. A-12/Recg/398-78 dated 22-11-1978 on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey the approval of the Director of Education, Delhi for the extension of Recognition of your school without Grant-in-aid for the classes from K.G. to XII for two years v.c.f. 1-5-79 to 30-4-81 subject to the following conditions.

1. The Management shall ensure that it has adequate funds to meet its financial responsibilities for regular payment of salary and allowances to its employees.
2. The Management shall ensure that the accommodation and sanitary facilities as well as all requisite accommodation are provided to the institution keeping in view any other facts, age and number of pupils attending it.
3. The Management shall employ teachers with prescribed qualification only.
4. The school shall not run for the profit of any individual, group or Association of individual or any other person.
5. Admission to the school shall be open to all without any discrimination on religious caste and place of birth.
6. The Managing Committee shall observe the provisions of Delhi School Education Rules, 1972.
7. The building and other construction in which the school is carried, its surroundings, furniture and equipment are adequate and suitable for an educational institution, keeping in view the number of the pupils and subject taught in the school.
8. The building and other structure or the grounds of the school shall not be used during the day or night for commercial political or non educational activities.
9. The facilities prescribed under Rule 51 shall be made available to the institution.
