

School Infrastructure:

Montfort Senior Secondary School is a Catholic minority unaided institution run by the registered Society of the Brothers of St. Gabriel with its head quarters at Rome and zonal head quarters in Bhopal. The society has institutions spread all over the globe in 33 countries. The Society runs about 120 institutions including schools, technical training institutes, orphanages, institutions for the differently abled (deaf, dumb and blind) and homes for the aged. The Society is also engaged in rural development programs and other programs for empowering the urban poor through Peoples' Initiative Net work and preservation of environment etc. under the nomenclature of St. Montfort, St. Gabriel, St. Francis, St. Charles, etc.

A beautiful fountain adorning the statute of the founder of the Society of the Brothers of St. Gabriel, St. Louis Marie de Montfort, finds a pride of place at the end of the drive way at the entrance to the school buildings, surrounded by beautiful seasonal flowers, and is the centre of attraction for all students, parents and visitors.

The school can boast of well maintained, well designed and well constructed school buildings of its own, with the main building at the very centre with a unique architecture, built on a 6.41 acre plot dotted with lovely green trees along the boundary. There are 180 rooms including 56 classrooms, the admin offices, five furnished staff rooms and four supervisors offices spread out on different floors, a large library for the middle and senior classes, a library cum reading room for the primary students, three computer labs, separate labs for Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Maths, two language labs, a room for eco-club, two art/ drawing rooms, three music rooms with a variety of musical instruments, two dance rooms, two spacious auditoriums/ halls fitted with hi-tech audio-visual systems to organize various activities.

Every floor is provided with clean, hygienic and well-maintained wash rooms for boys and girls, and machine-cooled filter-water is provided on every floor. There is 24 hours-running water and electricity thanks to the two standby generators. All rooms are well ventilated and fitted with safe electrical fittings, cupboards and curtains.

The teaching-learning process is enhanced with the help of Edu-comp Smart Classes provided for all the classes from Pre-School to Class VIII with the latest software.

Throughout the year students are busy with various activities preparing for inter school and intra school competitions and in-house programs like special assemblies to celebrate all national festivals, cultural programs, sports day etc.

Sports & Games:

Sports and games are an indispensable part of Montfortian education in all our schools. As per EW-C Fore Survey 2011 conducted by "Education World", Montfort school finds the 46th place among India's most respected 400 schools. And in Sports Education which is one of the parameters in the survey, Montfort School is proud of its No.1 position. This has been possible because of our commitment to the old adage 'a healthy mind in a healthy body'. Besides this, we also believe that good education should also help the students to appreciate the beauty of their body by taking care of it through healthy eating habits and exercise which will keep them physically fit, keeping obesity and many associated illness away. Good health and a good body are essentials for building up self esteem.

Towards attaining the above goal, we are privileged to have a very spacious and well maintained multipurpose play ground where children play cricket, football, athletics, march past etc 24 x 7.

Our two cemented basket ball courts (soon to become synthetic) have brought us glory and fame as our girls and boys have the best school basket ball teams in Delhi, and our girls have been the national champions in the CBSE Basket ball tournaments more than once.

Our latest addition to physical fitness are: a swimming pool equipped with dry and wet change rooms for boys and girls and Water Filtration Plant, and a gym for all.

Besides the above, we have the skating rinks, several Table Tennis Boards, badminton courts, volley ball courts and kho-kho grounds which are all always occupied by the enthusiastic youngsters.

Everyday (except Sundays) interested students are given coaching in the evenings by trained coaches in Cricket, Football, basket ball, badminton, Table Tennis, Tennis, skating, Chess and swimming (except in Winters).

Safety & Security:

The safety and security of our students has high priority. Then school is under surveillance on CCTV with a recording capacity of 72 hours. Along with it a team of professional guards (Max Securities) are on duty 24 x 7. No one is allowed to enter

the school buildings/ class rooms other than the reception/ school offices for safety reasons.

The school has license from fire department and all the required equipments are installed in the school premises on different floors. Exits are clearly indicated and free of obstructions. The routes to reach the exit are also clearly marked and signs posted to guide everyone on different floors. Alarm devices are installed to ensure prompt evacuation of the students and staff through exits. Exercises and training is given to responsible staff to operate the needed equipments in the event of an emergency.

First Aid:

There is a medical room under the supervision of a trained nurse to attend to any injury or illness during school time. For further emergencies we have immediate access to the Casualty section of neighboring hospitals like Sunder Lal Jain Hospital and Jivodaya Hospital which are within a distance of 5 minutes drive and where we have the prompt assistance of our own parent-doctors.

Guidance & Counseling Cell:

Guidance and counseling have become an important need in today's living, even among children. The school has a trained counselor who takes care of the emotional needs of students whenever they have a problem, and she also helps them to build up their inner strength and personality through formal personality development classes. Students also get all information about various career options. Parents and students can meet counselor in her office for any discussion/problem.

Public address system:

As children walk into the class rooms/ buildings in the morning they are greeted with devotional/ patriotic songs until the morning school assembly through the public address system which is a very nice way of starting the day. The PA system installed all over the school also enables to give any information or announcements.

Punctuality and Regularity in school is maintained through **the Bio-metric system.**

The school contributes its mite in saving the non-renewal resources of our country by installing two **Rain Water harvesting and solar water heating system** in the school.

Other attractions:

A 'mini zoo' with ducks, rabbits, pigeons etc. are a hit with the small kids who keep admiring the beauty of creation whenever they are not in the class room or out playing in the grounds.

The Science Park helps the students to see and touch some of the scientific principles displayed there.

The canteen, stationery and ice-cream stalls attract a lot of students and even their parents.

We understand our social responsibility, and therefore, we have about 260 poor students who are mostly studying / enrolled in government schools, coming to us in the afternoons for tuition/ coaching free of charge. They are taught by teachers specially appointed for this purpose.

At Montfort, we aim at "**Total Education**" which implies a holistic approach to education and which is concerned with the total development of an individual as a person. It imparts an appreciation for the Indian heritage and enables the students to imbibe its culture and ethos for building a harmonious society, irrespective of differences of faith, language, caste and class and at the same time to remain open to the positive elements of other cultures.
